


## PLACES TO EAT & DRINK

A gastronomic journey through the zoo: the zoo has wide range of culinary delights to satisfy every taste to refresh you on your day at the zoo! There are also numerous  kiosks to pick up a quick snack or drink.



### KAISERPAVILLON

The Kaiserpavillon, located in the centre of the zoo, serves traditional Viennese cuisine and international specialties. Its terrace looks out on to the giant pandas and the African animal enclosures.



### CAFÉ RESTAURANT ORANG.ERIE

With impressive views of the orangutans, the ORANG.erie café restaurant offers a range of international and Austrian dishes as well as vegetarian specialties.



### JUMBO GRILL GARDEN (April–October)

Enjoy food and drinks in the shade of the garden dining area on Jumboplatz, located between the elephant and penguin enclosures.

### GASTHAUS TIROLERGARTEN

(Tyrolean Garden Tavern)

### BIO ICE CREAM PARLOUR (April–October)

## HOUSE RULES (ABRIDGED)

- Visitors under 14 must be accompanied by an adult who is responsible for all children under their supervision during their visit.
- A strict feeding ban is in place throughout the zoo.
- Climbing over barriers and reaching into enclosures are strictly prohibited as they pose a significant danger to animals and humans. Anyone failing to comply will be reported to the police and refused entry to the zoo in future (permanent ban).
- Making excessive noise, knocking on windows and playing music are prohibited.
- Visitors must keep off the grass at all times. Causing damage to plants is prohibited.
- Bringing dogs or any other animals onto the grounds of the zoo is prohibited. Assistance dogs are permitted, provided they have a harness vest and an up-to-date immunisation record. The dog's ID and immunisation record must be shown at the ticket office.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters etc. cannot be used on the zoo premises. Ball games, frisbees etc. are not allowed.
- Use of the playgrounds is at visitors' own risk.
- Visitors may not bring balloons with them into the zoo.
- Please help keep the zoo tidy by using the bins provided.
- Visitors are welcome to make video clips and take photographs (without flash) for private purposes. However, commercial shoots require a permit.
- Please keep your admission ticket safe and be prepared to show it to a member of staff if asked to do so. Tickets are no longer valid once you leave the zoo.
- Visitors must leave the zoo without delay at closing time. The exit turnstiles are locked 30 minutes after the zoo closes.
- Instructions issued by employees of the zoo must be followed at all times.
- Staff members are entitled to ask any visitors who do not comply with the house rules to leave the zoo.
